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being compensated the same degree that they are in another area. Solely for the discretion of the Board of Regents, not to be utilized for any other purpose. And with that save the monies that were put in originally into the budget bill for merit raises. And I personally I think it's a good motion. But I'm trying to resolve some of these salary problems.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: First of all, I would say to Senator Stahmer in regard to 1053, if you want to hold the session for a few more days bring it back. I would suggest to you that you take your amendments on your previous motion and put it either on 1053 or one of the succeeding budget bills.

SENATOR STAHMER: All right, Senator Marvel, I will agree to do that. It was drawn for 1053, I don't think it makes that much difference.

SENATOR MARVEL: I don't think it makes that much difference. But it does as far as time is concerned. Secondly, I rise to oppose the amendment. I'm not opposing your amendment that you are trying to put on 1053, I'm opposing that you propose now.

SENATOR STAHMER: Yes, that's what I thought you meant.

SENATOR MARVEL: We can go all afternoon here, and continue to add money to this bill, and I assume we could justify what we are doing, up to a point. We have at your request, added staff, added..we've spent a lot of time with the administration and with the faculty at the University of Nebraska. I realize that there is some disagreement between the Ag College Faculty and the downtown faculty. I received today, a request for..or a invitation to attend a house breaking, or a house opening or whatever you call it for the new Vice Chancellor of the Ag College who is coming here, I think today is his first day. And I think we ought to give him a chance, since we have hired him. He is a new man. To come up with differences, agreements between the two campuses. And therefore, I think that this amendment, while I don't doubt Senator Stahmer's intentions. I think that this amendment, we should hold until the Vice Chancellor has had a chance to get his feet on the ground and see how he wants to handle the matter.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, if I could I'd ask unanimous consent to withdraw it. I think Senator Marvel has some excellent ideas, and...

PRESIDENT: You don't have to ask..It's withdrawn. What's the next amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There are no further amendments.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 1054 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All right, turn off your lights unless you want to speak. I'm not sure who wants to speak, but I'm going to recognize the lights. Thank you, one and all. One leaves his light on. Senator Nore.
