

levy the one mil to start with, and if you have a district that has an assessed evaluation that is higher than another district, naturally they are going to raise more money. That is what the law says. Now if you think that the law is wrong, then I suggest that you can change the law.

SENATOR LEWIS: What I am...

SENATOR MARVEL: All we are doing, excuse me, all we are doing is following the law. All I am doing is standing up here and indicating first of all that part of this combined area is a brand new operation. But you...seem to over look so you are starting as far as this one part is concerned, you are starting from scratch. The second point that I want to repeat, is that we are talking about the law. Now if you don't like the way the law is written, then you need to change the law, because the committee and the staff has to follow the law.

SENATOR LEWIS: I appreciate that, and....

SENATOR MARVEL: I appreciate it too, there are some people in this.....

SENATOR LEWIS: The two questions that I am going to ask Mr. President, if I may, number one, is metropolitan getting a less of state funding than the others? Less of state funding percentage wise. Yes, Senator Marvel? Well Mr. President, I won't prolong this, the hour is getting late, my point is that if we are going to start that, and my people were compromised into believing that this was the way to go, it is time to put the money in the program. We have got to have a start up for that school, we have got to continue with not only capital outlay, we have to do for operations. I think that fair is fair.

SENATOR MARVEL: All I am saying to you is that the law is the law. When you have a new district that is started, then that is also a different consideration. You are not listening to me but that is alright, the law is the law, and if you don't like the way the formula is set up, because one district has more assessed evaluation than others and despite what Senator Syas says to the contrary, my only answer to him is that and all you have to do is look at the record, nobody is trying to pick on Omaha, we are following the law that was passed. Now if you suggest that we do something other than that, fine.
