SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the Call be raised with this explanation. A lot of people want to get on General File and this.....

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson voting aye on the original motion. Excuse me, Senator, go ahead. Didn't mean to interrupt you, Senator. Did you make a motion, Senator? What was the motion? Oh, to raise the Call. Yes.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting no.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Clerk will clear the board. The motion has been made to raise the Call. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Motion is to raise the call. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 16 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, this is an important issue. We've got people not voting on it. We're trying to get to General File, yes, but let's not get so expeditious...that we jump off the band wagon here. We've got an issue before us.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder, I'm not getting expeditious about anything. Senator Carpenter made an allowable motion. I put it to vote. Call is raised. The Clerk will now see, vote on the original motion.

SENATOR SNYDER: May I ask for a Roll Call vote?

PRESIDENT: You can. Clerk call the roll.

CLERK: Roll Call. (Results on page 1441 of Journal).

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I move the bill be advanced.

CLERK: I'm sorry, there's another motion now, Mr. President. I move to return LB782 to General File and place it first on General File. Signed, Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, we all know this bill isn't going to pass. It's deader than a dodo bird. All right, someone says no, let's try to advance it. We'll find out.

PRESIDENT: Well, your motion as I understand it is to return it to General File. Senator withdraws the amendment. Back to you, Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion then is to advance to Final Reading. Is there any discussion on this? This requires 25 votes. All those in favor of advancing the bill to Final Reading vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? I'm about to record the vote. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 21 nays.
