PRESIDENT: No, that's not necessarily the answer. You going to leave your motion in there.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

PRESIDENT: I don't care. All right, Senator Carpenter has raised a point of order. We were on Final Reading. The bill is not on Select File. We are...we have not come to Select File yet but I'll recognize the chairman of the Rules Committee before I make this momentous decision. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I don't know whether I'm going to assist you here. What I have in mind here is following the rules, this bill is not on Select File. You'll have to wait until you get to Select File. Then the motion will be in order to return it for General File for no particular purpose at all and if it.....
