PRESIDENT: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I'm going to support this effort. I'd like to ask Senator Whitney a question. Senator Whitney, if you're so concerned about the rich people not paying their fair share of the taxes, would you be in favor of supporting a tax on the intangibles?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Savage, I supported a tax on intangibles here a few years ago when Senator Carpenter had it and I put an amendment that would include all intangibles and if we included all intangibles, I would support it.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. I oppose bringing this bill back to Select File for one reason. Because this bill has to do with ADC payments and the bill that we should be considering on food tax credit or taking the tax off is LB632 which is to be considered. It's my underlined bill and I hope you will defeat this attempt to bring it back and wait for LB632 to act on that. I'm sure there's amendments for that bill. I know Senator Keyes has an amendment to do this so I hope you do not bring this bill back. I think we're misleading the public by acting on a bill that does not refer to the food tax. I think everybody that LB632 is the bill that does deal with food tax credit and that's the bill we should consider.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker and members of this Legislature. I, too, support LB632. I would oppose bringing LB977 back. I would oppose trying to substitute something which has not had a public hearing on LB977 and put this through on the very last day we're going to have a chance to do something with it. Let's defeat this motion. Let's bring up LB632 and make an intelligent decision on the bill which has had its public hearing which the public is aware of what we intend to do instead of quick bait-and-switch advertising as this is what we're doing. We're baiting and switching. We've said that LB977 is one kind piece of legislation and now we're trying to switch.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers is closing.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I have something to say about those who want LB632. I believe that they are sincere but LB632 is 22 bills down on General File. We have some appropriations measures to consider on Select File and I think I can safely say that LB632 is not going to be dealt with. There is a lot of conversation about increasing the food tax credit but a lot of people some I imagine in this Body even who don't understand how that works. The poorest
