SENATOR MARVEL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Originally on the tuition remission, the committee was particularly critical of the way the schools were handling athletic scholarships. Since the discussion in the committee the State Board of Technical Community Colleges has adopted a uniform policy. And so what this does is to reinstate the basic remissions as far as the schools are concerned.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, I would like to have a more detailed statement of what it does, dollarwise and everything else, and why you changed your mind. You're a great exponent of saving money.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, the total amount of monies is \$192, 175.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now, what does it do?

SENATOR MARVEL: It's divided into two categories. One is that it allows tuition remission, general tuition remission. The other has to do with athletic remission.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now, your amendment puts all the athletic scholarships back to where they were?

SENATOR MARVEL: And the tuition remission money that was taken out.
