SENATOR MARVEL: It actually can be used either for athletics or for tuition remission.

SENATOR STAHMER: And basically the tuition remission would be probably to help the poor students and/or would some of it be like scholarship money for bright kids, too, or....?

SENATOR MARVEL: This puts the burden, Senator Stahmer, on those in charge of these institutions to determine where the money can best go to do the best job possible.

SENATOR STAHMER: All right fine. Now, one last question. You've got roughly, you said, what, \$190,000 or what was..?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes. Yes. \$192,175.

SENATOR STAHMER: All right now, how is this broken down by school and/or region? I mean was it based on the size of current enrollment or?

SENATOR MARVEL: No, it's a reinstatement of the money and the programs...it's a reinstatement of the money tied to the programs that they had previously.

SENATOR STAHMER: Oh, what about the schools that had no athletic scholarships?

SENATOR MARVEL: Then they have no money in there. There are three of them involved.

SENATOR STAHMER: In other words, they're not going to get any money out of this?

SENATOR MARVEL: There's no money in this amendment, that's true. Here, you want me to show you the figures.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, I wasn't just sure how you arrived, in other words, Lincoln didn't have any athletic scholarships, Omaha didn't, so they don't get any money out of this?

SENATOR MARVEL: No, it's reinstated what they had.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, personally I would favor a remission if we were to distribute the money on perhaps on a head count basis through the state so that all areas would benefit equally because I think this now a state program. And I think personally if this can be drafted in such a way that all areas benefit equally, I think it would help Senator Carpenter and others who weren't on budget. One of the problems when we addressed ourselves to remission, some people had athletic scholarships. Others didn't. They had zero. And I think whatever we do instead of going back to the old uneven mountains and valleys, we'd ought to adopt some kind of a program on a head count basis.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, let me make one more statement and I'll give this form to you and if you want to change the amendment, that's your privilege. And that is that in the committee action, we reduced the amounts for the schools
