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it is withdrawn. And, Senator Stahmer has the right to put on or offer another amendment if he wants to, but the rules provide that the proposer of an amendment can withdraw it, and I don't see where the Chair has any choice. All right, Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and members of the body. I'm not enthusiastic about it, but Senator Luedtke pushed for a building. He is...I am not misleading you. I sat in the room when the committee voted to building in Omaha. I only know what my own eyes and ears see and hear. And I'm giving Senator Luedtke what his committee wanted. Now let's find out who is misleading whom.

PRESIDENT: All right, there is nothing before the house. The amendment is withdrawn and we are going to proceed to the next amendment. And if you have an amendment to offer, Senator Stahmer, please do it.

SENATOR STAHMER: I'm trying to. I'm going to put an amendment down there...

PRESIDENT: Well, we've got to take these amendments in their order. Now, Senator Luedtke's amendment has been withdrawn. We will proceed to the next amendment. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senator Waldron. It's found on page 1377 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move the amendment be adopted. I'll try not to take up much of your time. I know the hour is late, and from the way it sounds around here, maybe our temperatures are becoming a little bit short, but the reason I...this is an amendment that will authorize and provide \$120,000 to outstate Nebraska and specifically to Lincoln County to build a recreational road on the west side of Lake Maloney or in that General area. We have written it general to try to get over the constitutional problem if we can. In specifically allocating, which is unconstitutional if it specifically allocates money to a certain road. But so I would hope that we would adopt this. And let me explain why we are doing it this way, rather than going through the Game and Parks Commission and asking for the money for recreational road. We have a paid road on the other side of the lake, and the people around in the north Platte area believe we should have one on the west side. And I believe that myself. The Games and Parks Commission, due to some personal disagreement and due to some other things in North Platte, have sort of indicated to the people that are interested in this road in North Platte, that there will be a certain area that becomes very cold before this road is ever built. And that is why we can't get it through the recreational roads provision. And that is why I am here now. It is a recreational roads, let me assure you of that. But due to certain personality conflicts, we have not been able to get it on the regular schedule, and I could not put it in the budget of the Game and Parks Commission, because they would be unlikely to build it. So I would like to mention to those members here, I think this is justified, as other recreational roads are justified. Would like to remind those that were here for other amendments, that I have supported their amendments, and I would ask that you support this amendment.
