SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I see that...maybe we could get a few people more in their seats. I wouldn't...you know I could. I only need six more vote...I wouldn't ask for a Call of the House, but with reasonably certain that I could have a fair chance of getting this amendment on...there are 15 absent which would look like we might have a you know fairly good chance.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to make the motion, or not.

SENATOR WALDRON: I'd like to have a Call for the House.

PRESIDENT: Clerk, clear the board. The question is made for a call for the House, all those in favor of a call of the house vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is Senator Waldron's motion for Call of the House. Have you all voted? Motion is for Call of the House by Senator Waldron. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 17 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. The Clerk will announce the vote on the original motion.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 15 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. What is the next amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Motion on the desk. Clerk will read.

CLERK: I move that we adjourn until 9:00 tomorrow. Signed Senator Fred Carstens.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk, there is another matter you mentioned to me that you forgot.

CLERK: Oh, yes. I would like for you to direct for us to print all further amendments in the Journal. I also have a series of other things.

PRESIDENT: I so direct.

CLERK: Senator Richendifer would like to be excused tomorrow. Senator Dickinson would like to be excused until he arrives tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: That's all, Mr. President. Now, I move we adjourn until 9:00.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adjourn until...Senator Duis, for what purpose do you rise. This isn't debatable.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you very much. I won't debate it.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of adjourning until 9:00 a.m. Say aye. Those opposed say no. Please stand adjourned.
