SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, in my responsibility as the self appointed floor leader, if you will recall two weeks ago I made a motion to take all of the underlined bills off of general file without amendments and discussion and put them on Select File. Now I told you then that it was my humble judgment that if you didn't do that you probably wouldn't get back to General File. If I recall I didn't get very many votes to do that. I would certainly be opposed to tacking to my motion what Senator Barnett wants to do. I think that it ought to be determined on its own. While we are here we might as well also take up Senator Burbach's motion, I presume that he will make one to extend the session, beyond the forty days which I am opposed too. I think that we all know what we are going to do. We will not do any good by talking about in my judgment very much longer. I move the question and to vote on the motion as I have it and then Senator Barnett can make another motion and it can be tied into this as an addition or whatever he wants to accomplish.

SENATOR BARNETT: That is fine with me. I'll withdraw my motion and then at the same time I would like to call for the question so that we could get on.

SPEAKER: Yes, and the Chair would observe that whether we go to General File or not, it is entirely a different subject and that would require a suspension of the rules. We have before us the Carpenter motion and he has now asked for the question. Now if you will Mr. Clerk read the Carpenter motion.

CLERK: Read Carpenter Motion.

SPEAKER: Alright, now the question has been called for. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER: The debate is ceased. Now the question is Clerk will clear the board, whether or not we should adopt the Carpenter motion. The question is on the Carpenter motion. If you are for it vote aye, if you are against it vote no. Have you all voted? This is a very important motion. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes 10 nays.

SPEAKER: Motion carries. Any petitions or memorials Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None.
