SPEAKER: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR C. CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the legislature I'm not asking for a overruling of the chair but I do think that amendment that was read by the Clerk was not fully explained by the introducer. He did not go into detail on it at all about those bills going to the bottom. I don't think that we really knew that we were voting for that.

SPEAKER: Fine, Senator Carsten the way to handle this the Chair may agree or disagree with you, but we are all adults here and we make mistakes. The way to correct that if it is a mistake is to over rule the Chair. I take no offense at that at all. Unless someone wants to over rule the chair we are going to proceed. Alright 656, the Clerk will read. That is the bottom of General File, pardon me. 934 I believe is the next bill.

CLERK: Read 934

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I move that we go back to the motion that was voted on and get it clearly understood and let this body vote on what they actually thought was in the motion.

SPEAKER: I consider that motion out of order. The proper way to do this is to over rule the Chair and I don't...
