

SENATOR FOWLER: Right.

SPEAKER: Motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Clerk will read the next bill.

CLERK: Read LB937.

SPEAKER: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President members of the legislature, this is a non-controversial bill in my opinion that merely is put into expedite legal advertising and from the cities the size of Omaha, that put it in a daily newspaper rather than to have to wait for a weekly. I move for the from General File to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? Ready for the question? Question is shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, members of the legislature LB...first of all I move that it be advanced to E & R for review. LB982 is to in...a...a..to encourage enlistments in the National Guard. This bill in the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee decided that since we have a lot of vacant seats within our colleges and universities and in our Voc. Tech. schools, that if we could probably do two things by this bill. Not only encourage the filling of those vacancies but we also give a 50% tuition waiver to those individuals who are full time servants within the National Guard. National Guard is having some difficulty in enticing young men to enlist within their ranks and I think that this would be an incentive. Many other states give incentives such as this and a lot more. The state of Nebraska has given very little incentive for young men to serve in our national guard units. I think that this bill is good, and so that is all there is to say about the bill and then I could take up my amendment. I'll explain it very briefly if the Clerk wants to read it.

CLERK: Read amendment.

SENATOR WALDRON: Now Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, this amendment, and I want you to be very careful and I don't want you to take this amendment if you think that it will harm the bill. This would extend the same privilege to the army reserve units that are here...army, naval and marine reserve and Air force reserve units that are in the state of Nebraska.
