

SHOULD be taken vote against it, there will be no strong feelings by myself one way or the other but they are having the same problems as the national guard and I would rather take care of the national guard first, so if you think that you have any problems with including the reserve units of the state of Nebraska or the United States REserve units, then vote against this amendment. Otherwise, I think that we should do it with the reserves as well as the national guard. But I don't want to jeopardize the bill because the National Guard is more close to all of us because it is a state run organization. But...I would move for the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Waldron, the Chair would note that we have five lights on here. At such time that you feel they are taking too much time I will recognize you. Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. Chairman, members, I...this is one bill that I underlined and it isn't my bill but I happen to have that privilege. I am a little bit dubious adding this amendment on for fear that it might allow too many remissions. Now Senator Waldron, how many more omissions, or how many more reserves do we have? What kind of an impact would it have on this...

SENATOR WALDRON: Senator we want to move this bill so I'm going to make it very easy. I withdraw the amendment, and I will offer it on Select File, and that will support that problem.

SENATOR NORE: I do support 982, I think that it is something that is needed and along this line, it probably isn't germane here but I think that it is time we start rewarding some of the folks in especially state positions and...please let me talk please.....I have a point that I want to get over here that I think that we are forgetting our veterans. Especially in this State House. I think that all veterans should have a priority on jobs....in the state and in the national government. This is not being carried out.

SPEAKER: Senator Waldron, did you withdraw your amendment?

SENATOR WALDRON: Yes.

SPEAKER: Senator Waldron has withdrawn his amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is pending an amendment offered by Senator Goodrich would read amendment.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, this is an amendment to add state patrol, paid police and paid fire departments and I have discussed this with the introducer of the bill and it is OK with him. I would like to point out that there has only been for example a total in the last 10 years there has been only a total of 5 firemen killed in the line of duty and these men, the widows and the children of these men would be hard put to get this kids through school if we don't take care of them in this way. I move the adoption of the amendment.
