

of the city of Omaha to come to Lincoln to transact the business. We would not be implementing operating agencies transferring them from Lincoln to the city of Omaha but provide service agencies and services to the city of Omaha.

SENATOR LEWIS: It would be only as a contact office.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: In the case of welfare for example, welfare currently maintains a staff in Omaha, I think that they have about 7,000 square feet to construct or conduct quality control and quality checks of welfare recipients and of course you know the majority of the welfare people are in Omaha and the state has the responsibility of checking upon the county welfare office that recipients of welfare benefits are receiving adequate benefits and are not receiving benefits for which they are not entitled. In order to do that they must maintain a staff who works regularly with the county office and in close proximity and in that case that is a continuing operation of the welfare department and it is also a necessary one to have close geographical proximity in order to carry out these functions.
