SPEAKER: You are on the wrong amendment Senator Syas. Lets finish this one off and then we can come back to that. Any further discussion? Senator Warner do you want to close on your amendments? This is Senator Carpenter's amendment being handled by Senator Warner. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? I held the board open long enough Senator Warner? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 19 nays.

SPEAKER: Amendment is lost. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the other amendments very briefly. I understand that the...

SPEAKER: Just a moment please. Mr. Clerk is there an amendment on your desk?

CLERK: Yes, Now I have the Warner amendment.

SPEAKER: Alright, there is no other amendment on the desk. Proceed Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I'm just going to say briefly that the amendment does what I already said, and I understand the reluctance of supporting the rate fixing procedure that 1032 would establish on the service commission. I'm supporting it for the one reason that seems to be one alternative to get some transportation to move farm grain this fall. Without this I don't know what other solution that you can find. Everyone of us have had call after call every fall as everyone in public office does. We need box cars, we need some way to move grain and Senator Keyes handed out a paper here to you the other day showing what it cost one elevator in his area or the farmers in his area or the farmers in his area the inability to get box cars. I had one elevator that lost some several thousands of dollars last fall because grain could not be moved and the Omaha terminals would take it by truck and it laid outside and rotted. This is one alternative to do it and as far as a solution I suppose is the bitter pill of accepting some rates but you can't get the public...as I understand it the public service commission could not unless they had the authority to supervise the transportation of goods in this area. I would hope that you would at least adopt the amendment. Let it get to select file if you have looked at it then and don't like it you can forget it. But I think that if offers more of an alternative than many of you are probably initially realizing.

SPEAKER: The time has just elapsed. The question is shall the Warner amendment be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Question is the adoption of the Warner amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? This requires 25....calling for the last time. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 12 nays.

SPEAKER: Amendment fails.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that 1032 indefinitely be postponed. Signed, Senator Kremer.
