SPEAKER: The Chair would rule that Senator Mahoney has the right to underline the bill that he wanted. Now there is another bill that he wanted up there and he wanted it up there badly and I went against him, because I tried to treat everybody the same. But we have commenced considering this bill. I am going to rule that the bill can be considered but of course anybody can put a kill motion on that wants to. Now where are we in the stage of consideration?

CLERK: The Richendifer amendment.

SPEAKER: The Richendifer amendment. Now...is there any further discussion on the Richendifer amendment? Senator F. Carstens. Passes. Are you ready for the question on the Richendifer amendment? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. We are voting on the Richendifer amendment. It requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 1 nay.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk was this an amendment to the bill?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Amendment failed.

CLERK: Read another amendment.

SPEAKER: Is there any objection to adding the E Clause? Any objection to adding the Emergency Clause? That will require 25 votes technically. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I would just like to overrule the Chair if I could. I would like to go back and say that I want this bill withdrawn. I wanted it killed.

SPEAKER: If you want it killed, why don't you put a motion on the desk.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I'll put a motion on the desk, but since I couldn't have 630 up there I think that you should honor me
