

SPEAKER: Committee amendment is adopted.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. Chairman, I move the bill be advanced to E & R Initial.

CLERK: Just a second, I have another amendment.

SPEAKER: Another amendment, Mr. Clerk. Senator Anderson is this your amendment?

SENATOR ANDERSON: If it is my amendment I ask unanimous consent to withdraw it.

CLERK: A....

SPEAKER: It is withdrawn.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. Chairman, I move the bill be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Did you ever explain the bill?

SENATOR ANDERSON: Yes sir, I explained the bill with the amendments.

SPEAKER: Alright, is there any further discussion? Senator Whitney you have had your light on here for about an hour. Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. Now LB1002.

CLERK: Read LB1002.

SPEAKER: Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, the committee amendments become the bill. What it would do, is to simply let villages have a retirement program for the workers just as we now do for all other cities in the state of Nebraska. I move the committee amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER: Any discussion of the committee amendments? Any further questions? Ready for the question? All those in favor of the committee amendments vote aye, those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Committee amendments are adopted. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: I move the bill be advanced to E & R Initial. I just explained the bill, it just simply lets villages have retirement programs for their workers like you do all other cities in the state.
