

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move the adoption of the committee amendments Mr. President. Mr. President, the committee amendments do two things. They first of all merely change the designation of the word corrections to community centers and take out the reference to corrections for labeling and purposes only and secondly they establish in the department of correctional services an alcohol and drug abuse treatment center. Or set up the provisions for the mechanics of such a drug and alcohol treatment center. These are the only things that the amendment does, and I move the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER: Any discussion on the committee amendments? If not, are you ready to vote? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. This is for the adoption of the committee amendments and it requires 25 votes. If you are going to vote please vote. Guess we will have to have a call of the house. Have you all voted? This requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER: Committee amendments are adopted. Any more amendments Mr. Clerk? No further amendments, what is your pleasure Senator Luedtke?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that D40 be advanced to E & R and this is a bill which is the corrections bill for one of the most important bills of the session actually for the judiciary committee and corrections. It sets up four different divisions in the department of corrections and this was recommended by the governor in his address to the citizens conference on corrections adopted by the Judiciary Committee and the amendments that you have now adopted will make the drug abuse and the alcohol treatment center conform to that which Senator Barnett had previously outlined before this body and it would also make the moder designation of the department of corrections follow that same sort of line. This will have the administration of the division of correctional services have a more integrated correction for the state of Nebraska. I move the adoption of the bill.

SPEAKER: Motion is to advance, and is that right Senator Luedtke? Is there any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? Question is shall LB1040 be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay. Mr. President, motion on the desk.

SPEAKER: Clerk will read.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I don't want to argue so I will just ask that a vote be taken.

SPEAKER: Alright, the motion has been made by Senator Chambers to suspend the rules and allow amendment to bills on general file by a majority of those voting. Have I correctly stated the question?
