

CLERK: 12 ayes, 19 nays.

SPEAKER: Motion looses. LB681, is that right Mr. Clerk?

SPEAKER: Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, members of the legislature, the amendment although only a matter of a few words, is very important in the committees opinion to the bill, and on page 3 line 13, strike not and insert who is a guest of. It has to do the revocation of liquor licenses and the discrimination section. We felt that as the bill was printed it would allow the confescation of the liquor license in a matter that was not the intent of the bill. So what we are saying is that it is discrimination and it would have to occur to a person who is a legitimate guest of a person who is a guest of a member of a private club, prior to that the bill just simply read that it could not occur to a person not...in other words a person not a member of a private club could not be discriminated against. Of course, that would just wipe out the public orprivate clubs of any degree. The amendment clarifies that part to where the discrimination can only be brought about in the and legitimized by the person being a guest of a member of that club. Mr. Chairman, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER: FINE, You heard Senator Snyder explain the amendments is there any discussion? These are committee amendments to the bill aren't they Senator Snyder? If there is no further discussion, all those in favor of the amendment vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.
