CLERK: 32 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That finishes the underlined bills. I now recognize the Chairman of the Appropriations committee, Senator Marvel.

CLERK: Motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Motion on the desk. Clerk will read.

CLERK: I've got so many motions, I don't know which one you want.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute, I recognize Senator Marvel, regardless.

SENATOR MARVEL: Mr. President, will you read my amendment please.

CLERK: I move we go to Select File and take up 1055, 1056, 1058 and 1049.

PRESIDENT: All right, now let's understand this. This is called the suspension of the rules because we are on General File. It calls for 30 votes. The motion is that we suspend the rules and go to Select File. Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Senator Marvel, might I make a suggest we take the simpler bills first, and then I think we can shot for them fast, and then take 1055 last.

PRESIDENT: Well, I think Senator you can make that when we get to Select File. Let's decide the basic question. Whether or not we're going to Select File. Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, Mr. Speaker I don't think we have ever discussed these bills yet. Very little on Select File. Not on General File, so sometime maybe they ought to be discussed. But I'm ready to go if you want to pass them all in a lump sum good.

PRESIDENT: All right, are you ready for the question. Senator Marvel may close if he desires.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Keyes, misunderstands the motion. The motion is to go thereto for the purpose of discussing the bills.

PRESIDENT: This is the purpose of the motion, Senator Keyes to go directly from here to Select File for the purpose of discussing the bills on Select File. Are you ready for the question. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Requires 30 votes Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: We are now on Select File. Mr. Clerk what is the first bill on Select File. Senator Syas do you want to be recognized.

CLERK: Under the motion, it would be 1055.

PRESIDENT: You can't be, it's rejected. You may be excused. All right, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: What bill are we on, Senator Marvel.
