CLERK: Yes, I do have.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach, excuse me. It has been called to the Chair's attention quite correctly that we were on Select File. Now we've gone to E & R

SENATOR BURBACH: Aren't we finished on Select File.

PRESIDENT: No, we're not, and the Chair was in error on that and I trust that you will be gracious enough to wait for Senator Snyder. Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: No response.

CLERK: The motion is to adopt the Snyder amendment to LB875 on Select File.

SENATOR SNYDER: Very very quickly this is a bill dealing with the last transit package from the Urban Affairs Committee. The amendment asks for one mill less, which this is a compromise among the delegation, by the way. It also removes the option of using highway fund money for mass transit. Now those are the areas that we have been debating over the last two or three weeks. So it's a major change. A compromise worked out on the floor. So I would ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder is asking for the adoption of his amendment as he has explained. Is there any further discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes for the adoption- of the Snyder amendment. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Any further amendments.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: What do you do with the bill, Senator.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move 875 as amended be advanced. to E & R Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any further discussion. Are you ready for the question? The question is, shall the bill be advanced as amended? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to advance the bill. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Do you have anything else on Select File, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes, we have LB875A. The E & R amendments have...there are no E & R amendments. There is a Snyder amendment page 1 line and 2 strike the corrected dollar figures. Signed, Senator Snyder.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy are you asking to be recognized. All right, will you hold your motion, Senator Snyder.
