SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment to LB875A.

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any discussion of that? Do you want to explain it?

SENATOR SNYDER: I think I'd better.

PRESIDENT: I think you should too.

SENATOR SNYDER: This deals with the reduced fair for the elderly persons riding public transit in the State of Nebraska. And because of the statewide impact and because of the increased ridership of the amendment calls for going from \$200,000 to 1,000,000 to cover the cost of the action by the Legislature with LB875.

PRESIDENT: All right now, you have heard Senator Snyder explain the amendment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of the amendment to LB875A vote aye, those opposed vote no. This is Senator Snyder's amendment to LB875A. Have you all voted? Senator Snyder's amendment to LB875A. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Now, Senator what do you do with the bill.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB875A as amended be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: All right, all those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, all those opposed no. The bill is advanced. Now I...Is there anything else on Select File. Senator Burbach, we are still on Select File. Senator Kennedy what...did you want to be recognized? Passes for now.

: Mr. President is there a motion up there to adjourn.

PRESIDENT: Is there, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Sir.

: I do so move.

CLERK: I have had several for several hours. I move to adjourn until Monday at 10:00. Signed, Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: All right now, this motion is not debatable. Now the Chair will explain the situation. We've still got some bills on Select File. Senator Burbach did have a motion which I did not take, this is all up to you. Are you ready for the question? The question is, shall we adjourn until 10:00 a.m. Monday morning. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 19 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. We will continue on Select File.
