CLERK: Mr. President. LB757. It has E & R amendments, plus a series of other amendments. Well, it has some E & R amendments, and then it has to be advanced, because it was replaced.

PRESIDENT: Whose bill is this?

CLERK: Senator Dickinson's. Senator Cavanaugh would handle the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E&R amendments say aye, opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, the bill has to be advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Dickinson...have you taken your amendment off?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Yes. I asked unanimous consent to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: You asked unanimous consent to withdraw, Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Withdrawn. What else do you have, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, it was returned for an E & R amendment.

PRESIDENT: Oh, this was returned for an E & R amendment, so it has to be readvanced, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: O.K. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: All right, those in favor of advancing it, say aye. Opposed, no. It's advanced.

CLERK: O.K. Now, Mr. President LB302.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Well, can I return it and get my amendment on while we are here.

PRESIDENT: You cannot, because we are on Select File. Now, if I rule that way, Senator Cavanaugh, I would then have to rule that Senator Burbach can do his, so I don't see how I can rule otherwise. We are on Select File, and when he gets on E & R we are not on Select File, and that would be a deviation and I don't think I can permit that. What's the next bill on Select File.

CLERK: LB302, Mr. President, there are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: LB302.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments.
