PRESIDENT: How about that? Thank you, sir. Senator Syas, did you want to be heard? All right, any further discussion of Senator Marvel's motion? Do you all understand the motion? All right then, the question is, do you want to suspend the rules and go direct to Select File? If you do, vote aye. If not, vote no. Motion is to suspend the rules, go direct to Select File and handle the bills there. You've all had a chance to express your opinion. CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays, 12 not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Ready to advance the bills off of Select File. Are you ready, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: We're trying to get an order up here, Mr. President. The ones correctly engrossed first.

SENATOR MARVEL: Trying to help you.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, we need to establish an order here. Be at ease for just a minute here until we get this squared away.

SENATOR DUIS: All right, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB1028 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB1028. Was it?

SENATOR DUIS: Yes.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments, please say aye. Those opposed please say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DUIS: Now, I move that LB1028 be advanced to E & R final for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB1028. Frank Lewis, do you have some discussion on LB1028?

SENATOR LEWIS: LB1054.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB1028 as amended. All those in favor of advancement of the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill's advanced.
