And I think it is a good bill that come out of committee. I think we should leave it alone and reject all amendments and pass it as it is, because this bill has been held up for a year. Because of people offering amendments which were not satisfactory to make a good bill. So I would urge you to reject all the amendments and pass 302 as it came out from Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: My concern in this area stemmed from the same thing that Senator Maresh brought out, which is where is the duplication and the overlap and will it truly eliminate anything. And it was prompted when we came into 403 last year, which was going to put high schools in the education of handicapped children, and it seemed to me that we just added or contemplated adding another agency. Now I am already in five mental regions at home, and none of those five regions have any coordination whatsoever. I'm in region 4 out of Wayne, I'm in region 4 out of Norfolk. I'm in region 4 out of Columbus. I'm in region 7 out of Kansas City, and I'm also served by the ESU's in this same field. Now as far as duplication goes, I would simply point out to Senator Maresh, that in section 11, it says that within the two the current clinics, as they exist, as they are leave much to be desired, will be phased out. And that this will replace them, and the final sentence in that paragraph is, However, however, there is nothing in this section to be construed to prohibit the Director from establishing anyother facilities or services that he deems fit. And I say to you there is duplication being prepared for. Now, I again repeat. I think we need to coordinate many of these. Why a region at home that sends a permission out of Norfolk to deal with the mentally handicapped and then the agency, the regional agency that is presently there, has to go to Iowa and hire a Phycologist, when they need one, to me is pitiful evidence of duplication. None of these agencies use the same facilities, none of them use the same phycologist, but they all use the same appropriations committee. And I think we owe it to the people of this state to take a very careful look at this complete duplication.

PRESIDENT: All right, now Senator Maresh, you light is still on then does that mean that you want to be heard again. You are through. O.K. Senator Marvel, we are back to you.
