SENATOR WARNER: (mike not activated) Mahoney, but I think that there are amendments pending on other bills too, that are on E & R or even on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I have a motion up there since this morning and I would respectfully request that you pose that question and if Senator Mahoney wants to amend that motion that is fine, my motion has been up there since this morning. The motion simply reads that we do not meet tomorrow that we meet Wednesday and Thursday of this week and then we adjourn until Thursday of next week, to fulfill our duties to allow the Governor time to review what we do and then to come back and determine what we want to do. Now, I move that that motion be posed and the motion does in effect after we finish Select File today and then if Senator Mahoney wants to amend that motion, that is fine. All I want to do is to insist that we have discussion on the fact that this legislature reserves one day to review what the Governor has done. If I may say in all due respect Senator Mahoney if we put him under the pressure now, of trying to hurriedly veto whatever he wants to do, I think that we are also being unfair to the whole process. So I move that my motion be considered.
