to make the motion and I hope that we would vote now that we have as a regular workday tomorrow. This legislature changes from day to day and tomorrow you might change your whole plan. Lets just talk about tomorrow. I amend his motion to meet for tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: Alright then the way that it stands right now Senator Marvel...or Senator Mahoney is amending Senator Marvel's motion which would mean that we would meet tomorrow. That is the question under debate right now. Whether you are going to adopt the Mahoney amendment which would have you meet tomorrow. Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: The only question that I would have in my mind Mr. President, what day would we not meet Thursday and still meet on.... YOU REALLY have a substitute motion then I think that it would be clearer if you would just substitute your motion to meet tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: The problem is that Senator Marvel is motion was up here and that has to have some priority over.... Senator Mahoney's motion which was made from the floor. It was already filed. There were a...a...are there other motions? Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I would ask the Chair to clarify what the amendment to my motion is. I would like to....I don't know how you can amend a motion that I have to simply say that we are going to meet tomorrow. That does not solve the problem. The key to my motion is that we reserve a day for next week, and I repeat what I have said that I think that the Governor to fulfill his duties ought to have more time than to work inbetween these sessions as to determine what he item vetoed. If I had my way we would override him item by item, but the Attorney General says that we can't do this. I would respectfully say that the amendment to the motion is not germane.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Marvel, three different times you have made the point that you want to be fair to the Governor and you have got that point across well and good. I think that all we are trying to say here from the Executive Board is that we are going to have a meeting tomorrow and that tomorrow this legislature is a...a...101 times is or has changed what it is going to do from day to day. We grow weary at the end of the day. Lets take up the other part of your motion tomorrow. I would like to amend that motion Senator Marvel just to say that we meet tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the Chair is in a difficult position here in that obviously enough that the question actually before the body is that are you going to meet tomorrow or not, and that is it. But the question does relate to meeting Wednesday and Thursday. Also, actually the question is to meet or not to meet. Ha! Senator Mahoney do you want to withdraw your amendment or not? Are you going to leave me here with this to decide?

SENATOR MAHONEY: I'll withdraw the amendment and ask that you vote down Senator Marvel's motion because his motion would have that we not meet tomorrow and then let me put mine in.
