

A simple majority is all that is required. SENATOR Wiltse motion is to adjourn. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Motion is for adjournment. As long as I see Senators Clerk will record.

CLERK: 14 ayes 24 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.

CLERK: Read explanation of vote by Senator R. Lewis.

CLERK: We now then go to LB632. Read.

PRESIDENT: There some possibility that Senator Whitney could come forward for a moment, please?

CLERK: Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the legislature, my amendment spells out that the refund or the credit is \$13 for each individual in the state and the original Marvel amendment provided for \$10. This puts it back as 632 left the committee and the committee had amended the original bill for \$12 to \$13. If the average figure per family is \$43.00 per week times 52 you come to a figure of just slightly larger than \$13, a little greater. The \$13 is a fair figure of...a fair compromise the committee did consider \$14 but adopted the \$13. We are right back to the \$13. Otherwise it leaves the amendment as it was for the \$18 to take effect after January 1, 1975.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Burbach amendment? Any further discussion? Senator Keyes, did you want to be heard on the Burbach amendment?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, Mr. president, if we kill the Burbach amendment that puts the bill just like it was when Senator Maresh had it.

PRESIDENT: It will not, it depends upon whether you adopt Senator Marvel's amendment if this body would adopt Senator Marvel's amendment without this amendment it would leave it at a \$10 credit. If you adopt this amendment then you are also taking into consideration, if you adopt the amendments to the Marvel amendment. The Marvel amendment carries, and it will raise in 1975 from 13 to 18. If you adopt this amendment and Senator Marvel's amendment carries, you would be going to 18 in 75. If it does not carry then the bill would be as it is before the Marvel amendment. This amendment goes back to the \$13.00 as it was as the bill left the committee, as Senator Maresh's bill left the committee at \$13.00.

SENATOR KEYES: In other words then Senator Burbach, all we have to do is kill your amendment and kill Senator Marvel's amendment and we have got it back where it should be?
