SENATOR WARNER: Senter Whitney what is the purpose of having the date effective January 1, 1975? Is that to reflect the additional 1% sales tax or do you have a different reason?

SENATOR WHITNEY: The purpose there is that Senator Burbach wanted to start in 75, January 1, and...

SENATOR WARNER: Is it to reflect the additional 1% sales tax?

SENATOR WHITNEY: No, it is just simply....I'm not saying anything about the sales tax or income tax, I'm talking about is the refund giving...

SENATOR WARNER: I understand, is it for the purpose of reflecting the additional 1% sales tax that would go into effect then?

SENATOR WHITNEY: No, it is not for that purpose.

SENATOR WARNER: Then you are in support of \$18 whether the sales tax is changed or not, is that it?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Obviously this \$18 is going to come out of the sales income tax.

SENATOR WARNER: You are in support of an \$18 food credit with or without state aid, is that your position?

SENATOR WHITNEY: That is my position at the present time, yes sir.

SENATOR WARNER: I see. Well...

SENATOR WHITNEY: Well this is your position, you want \$18 refund too starting January 1, 1975.

SENATOR WARNER: Because of the additional 1% sales tax.

SENATOR WHITNEY: That is your position, not mine.

SENATOR WARNER: Then can I ask, what is the rationale for the \$18 to in relation to the amount of food each individual buys, will the \$18 return more than there sales tax or less?
