SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I don't want to take any time. What this Resolution does and all it does is to put it on the ballot in the general election of this year in order to make the four normal schools, Chadron, Peru, Wayne and Kearney a part of the University of Nebraska. I'm sorry that I was gone several days but I couldn't avoid that so I want to move that the rules be suspended and we place this bill at the head of Select File.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke and then Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I would object to putting it at the head of Select File. I have a motion up there to take the bills that we were waiting on yesterday and we adjourned last evening with the understanding that we would finish those five bills that were up there as quickly as possible this morning so that we can get them acted upon. These are bills that have had hearings. The people are waiting to have action on and Senator Carpenter I have no objections to taking it up at the end of...after those have been taken care of.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I have no objection.

PRESIDENT: All right, amend that motion that way then.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: My motion then reads to add the Resolution on the end of the list.

PRESIDENT: Not quite. Let's....

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Okay.

PRESIDENT: Put it at the bottom.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: That's what I'm talking about, the bottom of Select File. That's what I'm talking about.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to suspend the rules and place LR133 then at the bottom of Select File. Okay, Senator Luedtke?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Well that's all right, that's right. If that's all right with Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Is that all right, Senator Carpenter. Thank you.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, I'd like to amend that by suggesting we put LR134 right behind LR133. They both deal with the same subject and both Resolutions were voted out of the committee after hearings. So I move to include LR134 right along with LR133.

PRESIDENT: All right, we have the Stahmer amendment then of the Carpenter motion. I think...that's right....I think the question could be divisible. I think.....

SENATOR STAHMER: I'll just ask for unanimous consent unless someone complains.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President and members. I think LR133 and LR134 are completely immature. We have a letter from
