

appropriated was \$1.1 million. It has already been stated that this amount of money which included buildings, utilities, architect's fees, etc. has already been taken care of in a bid, in a new bid which was opened yesterday. All the officials involved have to do is to accept that bid. That bid's accepted. The only thing this language does on page 6 is to tie it in with what's already under appropriations bill that you have at least moved along the line. And that is to set up \$2,500 to see what kind of structure design you want for additional buildings in the following year appropriate the money in the form of \$975,000. So the bid's been let. All the officials have to do is accept it and this language as far as I'm concerned first of all is broad enough so that Senator Carstens does not have to have the fear that he seems to have at the moment. And that between now and 1975-76, there's enough time that if there's any problem with design, it can be taken care of before the next money is appropriated. So I still think we ought to leave the bill where it is, pass it on to the Governor, and if you don't want to adopt the schedule that was set up yesterday and wait until these bills are vetoed, at least we've got a fighting chance if there's a disagreement between us and the Governor. Do something about it towards the end of the week so I think that as far as Senator Carstens is concerned, it's been decided. All the officials have to do is accept the bid. What we're talking about here is protected by what's going to be done between now and the time we appropriate the money next year.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: I, I was going to say something but I think Senator Marvel has said most everything that needs to be said. I'd call for the previous question.
