SENATOR CARPENTER: That's out of the matter of the bill, isn't it?

SENATOR STAHMER: Pardon me?

SENATOR CARPENTER: That is now out of the amendment, isn't it?

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, you just read it. Something about striking wine licenses or something. I don't know what that means.

PRESIDENT: Stand by.

SENATOR CARPENTER: In the amendment originally as I recall, there was a part there which would allow the issuance of a license only for the sale of wine. That should be stricken from the amendment if it's in there.

PRESIDENT: Stand by.

CLERK: Okay, then, Mr. President, as explained by Senator Carpenter, it does nothing with wine license. What the computer print out copy that I have has, it showed new matter and made a new provision for a wine license and then Senator Carpenter simply struck it so what he was doing was striking a change he had previously requested. So it does nothing to it now.

SENATOR STAHMER: So we're leaving wine licenses alone?

CLERK: Just as it is.

SENATOR STAHMER: Okay.

SENATOR CARPENTER: It leaves them exactly as they now are.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Richard Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, I'd like to ask Senator Carpenter a question if I might?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Senator, there's some reference made to the automatic renewal of Class C licenses? Could you give me an explanation of this?

SENATOR CARPENTER: As I understand it, it only changes the dates of advertising to alert the people that the Class C license is before the Commission, nothing else.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Nothing else? Okay.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Carpenter amendments? To LB681. Are you all through? Senator Carpenter, do you have any closing? All right, the question is do you want to adopt the Carpenter amendments? Senator Richendifer, you're up, do you want to be heard? Okay, the question is, do you want to adopt the Carpenter amendments to LB681? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.
