

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson, are you all through? All right Senator Schmit, then Fellman.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would like to ask Senator DeCamp a question.

PRESIDENT: Ask him the questions but don't give him the floor.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Basically the question that I want to ask is this. That if we adopt your bill, are we going to be in conflict in-so-far as the broadcasters are concerned and those people who report the markets and that sort of thing?

SENATOR DE CAMP: No, we would no.

PRESIDENT: Are there further questions? Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: No...

PRESIDENT: Alright question is then, do you want to advance LB651 if you do vote aye, if not vote no. This motion is to advance LB651 as amended. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced.

CLERK: Read unanimous consent request regarding 932.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, DO YOU want to make any speech regarding 932? OK, Senator Syas has a unanimous consent request to unbracket 932.

SENATOR SYAS: Well forthe tenth time I rise to this floor to urge this Senate to unbracket 932, if you do not have this the companion bill bill to 932 that is also bracketed you are not going to lead into a lot of trouble because the Lt. Governor and the Governor can not run together. That is what the people asked for. You have got to pass these bill unamended. If you want it the way it is, that is the way the Attorney General says and Alana Beerman. I have threatened before and again the candidates say in here then Senator Marvel and the three Lt. Governor candidates do not seem to want to take a hold of these two bills. So I move that we take them up now. 932 is on Select File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas a has asked unanimous consent to unbracket 932. Are there objections to unbracketing 932? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. We will take up 932.

CLERK: There are E & R amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: We have E & R amendments to lb932, does someone want to move the amendments? Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I move the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: YOU HEARD the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to 932. All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. the amendments are adopted. are there other amendments to the bill?
