

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

CLERK: That is all the amendments you can consider. There are other amendments but you have to advance it.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, the bill has to be advanced. Senator Marsh has moved to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing the bill, is there...all those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, a motion to return 932 to Select File to a...a..for select file for a specific amendment to strike the enacting clause, signed Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the legislature the problem was generated when an attempt was made to require the governor and the Lt. Governor candidate to run as a team. There are conflicting opinions among people who have studied this issue as to just exactly what this statutes do and to exactly what will happen if nothing is done with them. One thing is certain. If you do what I suggest that you do, the whole concept will be in a matter of speaking postponed at least until the next election. Each candidate for these offices will run as an individual. I am asking that 932 be returned to Select File.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion now? Senator Fellman your light is on. Do you want to be heard on 932?

SENATOR FELLMAN: Yes, I rise Mr. President and members of the legislature in opposition to Senator Chambers, and I would point out to you this. I think that two years ago or from the last election the voters of Nebraska voted in favor of a constitutional amendment to have the Governor and the Lt. Governor run as a team. It was passed and is now part of the constitution of this state. These bills attempt to execute that provision of the constitution. They carry it forth with necessary legislation that includes a method that will allow a person to run as a petition candidate which was an oversight. There is still a question that can be raised in the appropriate course about the propriety or the adequacy of the procedure for the petition candidate. But if you vote to kill this bill and its companion, if you follow the suggestion of Senator Chambers you are turning your back 180 degrees on the voters and the constitution of this state. It seems to me that the only responsible...it seems to me that the only responsible course of action of the members of the legislature can be to favorably pass 932 and 933 without this amendment. This amendment guts the bill and leaves only a skelton that does nothing. the amendment should be defeated and the bill passed.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion now? Senator Chambers do you have any closing? Senator Chambers is now closing on his motion to return 932 to Select File for specific amendment to strike the enacting clause. Senator Chambers has the floor.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: For the purpose of clarification 932 is to be returned to be indefinitely postponed. 933 I have an amendment to offer for that bill. So to kill the two from
