The reason Senator Chambers that you are against this is that this diminishes what you feel are your chances in federal court and I agree a 100% if we fail to pass this we have set up a far better law suit that serves your personal interest. I do not agree that it serves the interests of anyone who wants to comply with reasonable regulation for getting there name on the ballot as a petition candidate or anyone that wants to comply with reasonable regulation for getting there name on the ballot as a write in candidate. There members of this legislature there appears to be no legislation that we can look to as a guide. There have been a number of states that have within their constitution provisions such as ours.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would like Senator Fellman this is the first time that I think that you all have seen Senator Fellman evade answering a question. I asked him simply does this bill and its companion impose a condition on an independent candidate which is not imposed on a democrat or republican to seek the Governorship.

SENATOR FELLMAN: This is not an unreasonable condition and this is not an unreasonable or evasive answer. It requires him to do something comparable to the process of running a in a primary. The person who chooses to file as a Republican or a Democrat must comply with the provisions of the party primary. The person who runs by petition or write in must comply with a separate set of conditions. They are each imposed. They are different, they are reasonable. The answer to the question is that there is a difference but it is not an unreasonable or illegal difference.
