PRESIDENT: Next to speak is Senator Chambers. We are speaking on DeCamp's amendment to include 894 Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No response.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers I wonder if the microphone switch there has been turned off...Is it on. Thank you. You are on.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I stated that I'm aware that you said 894 included in Senator Wiltse's motion is the only thing to be discussed. But as I listened to the original motion, there is ambiguity in the placement of the words. If the clerk would read it, that I can state what I am talking about. And then I can get some understanding.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Will the Clerk please read Senator Wiltse's motion now, then...
