SENATOR SNYDER: Well, Mr. President, I am trying either to attempt to option or call for the House.

PRESIDENT: Well, let me know.

SENATOR SNYDER: I shall call for the House, if I may.

PRESIDENT: You are asking for a call of the House, Senator? Senator Snyder is asking for a call of the House. At the next bell, please indicate your support of the motion for a call of the House. Motion is for a call of the House. That's enough. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Twenty-two ayes; no nays.

PRESIDENT: Gentlemen and lady, we are now under a call of the House. Please take your seats. Senator Luedtke voting aye on the original motion. Next, at the next bell, please indicate your presence.

CLERK: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye. Motion under vote is the return of LB 94; it is the return only. Senator Barnett voting aye. Motion is to return LB 94 from final reading. Right now, I am asking you to indicate your presence on the board. Please indicate your presence. Senator Stahmer, please take your seat. We are having a call of the House. Senator Richendifer voting aye. Senator Skarda, we are under a call of the House. Would you mind taking your seat? Alright. Senator Snyder?

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I respectfully ask that the call be raised.

PRESIDENT: Alright, clear the board. Question is, do you want to raise the call? All those in favor of raising the call of the House, vote aye; all those opposed, vote no. Senator Luedtke, push your no vote for a minute. Alright, now, well, I am wondering about the totals. Senator Luedtke, vote no. Okay. This is a motion to raise the call. The Clerk will record. The call is raised. Read the total.

CLERK: Twenty-five ayes and four nays.

PRESIDENT: LB 94 is now returned to Select Files.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to adopt the specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Snyder?

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I so move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is, do you want to adopt the Snyder Amendment now to LB 94 on Select File? If you do, vote aye; if not, vote no. This is the vote on the specific amendment to 94; specific amendment offered by Senator Snyder to LB 94 on Select File. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Twenty-nine ayes, five nays.

PRESIDENT: Very good. The amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill?
