

many amendments that I had decided to attach to some of the appropriations bills, but in order to save time and to move those bills across, understanding the purpose and importance of them, I decided that we would not do that. First of all, let me say that this was not of a special interest bill to me or to my community. It is a small sum, it is \$29,000 to expedite justice and the process of the courts, I think that it is worthwhile, I don't think that it needs long debate. I would ask that you unbracket that bill and return it to Select File and adopt the specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Let's try unbracketing it first here. The question is, are there any objections to unbracketing 254? Any objections to unbracketing the bill, 254A, I think it is on Final Reading, any objections? Hearing none, so ordered, 254A is unbracketed then. Alright, read the motion again.

CLERK: Which one are we on?

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis's, it has been unbracketed by unanimous consent.

CLERK: Now the motion is to return it to Select File for the specific amendment. To add, or to strike section 1 and 2 and insert the following, "it is hereby appropriated \$29,559 from the State General Fund for the period ending June 30, 1975, the Supreme Court agency provides for Program 531 to aid in carrying out the provisions of LB819. Signed Senator Lewis.

PRESIDENT: Alright, any further discussion? Question is, then shall the bill be returned? This is the motion to return 254A only, you are returning the bill, all those in favor of that motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to return the bill. Have you all voted? Alright, Senator Lewis what is your pleasure?

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Well Mr. President, reluctantly I would ask for a Call of the House, and again, it is no big deal to me.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Senator Lewis is asking for a Call of the House. Therefore, Clerk will clear the board. At the next bell, please indicate your support for a Call of the House. Motion is for a Call of the House, do you support a motion for the Call of the House? Are you all through voting? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 16 nays.

PRESIDENT: We are now under a Call of the House. Senators will please take their seats. We are under a Call of the House gentlemen, please take your seats. The next bell, please indicate your presence. Please indicate your presence, Senator Dickinson, sit down. We are under a Call of the House. Senator Fellman, we are under a Call of the House. Please indicate your presence. Alright, Clerk will record. The motion under vote is the return of 254A to Select File for a specific amendment as offered by Senator Lewis and the motion is just to return the bill. That is all that is under question. Senator Skarda voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Skarda voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Point of order. Is this bill germane to put on 254?

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry sir?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Is it germane to put 819 on 254?
