

PRESIDENT: Alright Senator Syas. The motion is to advance LB677.

SENATOR SYAS: Well you know my view about this bill. I think that it is a bad bill and I am just leave it right there. We did advance it a while ago and I think the graveyard is a good place for it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke, do you want to be heard on the bill? Alright, any further discussion of the motion?

CLERK: I have a motion to advance Mr. President then I have a motion to amend, Mr. President, which one would you like to consider?

PRESIDENT: Thanks a lot. Well, Senator Carpenter?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that we consider the one to advance.

PRESIDENT: Thanks a lot. Alright, the questions is, shall LB677 be advanced. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, all those opposed vote no. It still takes 25 votes to advance the bill. The motion is to advance the bill, Senator Kelly for what purpose is your light on?

SENATOR KELLY: I would Call the House Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright Senator Kelly is asking right now for a Call of the House. Clerk will clear the board. At the next bell, please indicate your support of a Call of the House. Question is, do you support a Call of the House, if so vote aye, if not vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 15 nays. Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are now under a Call of the House.

CLERK: Senator Moylan voting aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: The next bell, please indicate your presence.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye on the original motion

PRESIDENT: Please indicate your presence. You are voting to indicate your presence. This is the vote to, thank you. Clear the board. Did the Chair hear a motion to raise the Call.

CLERK: Johnson moved to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All those in favor of raising the Call vote aye, all those opposed. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. Now read the tally on the original motion.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays.

PRESIDENT: LB677 is advanced. What is the next motion on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB938 to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed Senator Stahmer, the specific amendment is that \$183,000 now contained in the University of Nebraska Auxiliary Cash Fund resulting from the sale of the Mahoney Park Land at the Agronomy Farm, UNL be extracted, and the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska be authorized to expend such funds for the equalization of faculty salaries between UNO and UNL. Signed Senator Stahmer.
