

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, the Chair would have to observe that this is a reconsideration motion only, I don't know that we can go into the content of the bill. It is just whether you want to reconsider it or not, your action. alright, the question is do you want to reconsider your action? 25 votes are required. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to reconsider your action. Have you all voted? Alright, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 8 nays to reconsider Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: OK, Stand by. OK, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I should say am I in error again in assuming that on reconsideration on final it takes 30 votes.

PRESIDENT: REconsideration takes 25.

Stand by, you may be right. Well OK, this just only proves that none of us are infallible. What do you know about that it does take 30 votes because that was a vote or bill that lacked a constitutional majority so it takes 30 votes to reconsider the action on that. So here we are back again. The vote was not sufficient to carry the reconsider action. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I would like to retake the vote on that because of the fact that the misinterruption of the rules for the Chair foreclosed the actual full consideration of the vote that we could have asked for a call of the house and that sort of thing and we did not because of relying on your interpretation. I request that we retake the vote.

PRESIDENT: Alright, I think that is proper. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: He has got the same rule book I have. I didn't rely on the Chair.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: If I might inject a thought here, the bill did not lack the constitutional majority to pass this legislature, it only lacked a constitutional majority to make the appropriation.

PRESIDENT: If you are Chairman of the Rules Committee next year, will you take care of that please? Alright Senator F. Lewis, do you want to be heard.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I think in fairness of all the vote should be retaken. I think as Senator Goodrich said obviously when 25 votes were there people thought that it was over.

PRESIDENT: Chair is going to rule then that we will vote again on the reconsideration motion here regarding LB875A. All those of...all those in favor of reconsidering your action on 875A in view of the Chairs mistake vote aye, those opposed
