

SENATOR FRED CARSTENS: No, I move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the previous question has been moved. There isn't anyone else to speak. Question is, Senator Waldron do you want to close on your motion? No closing. The question is to suspend the rules and take up LB134. All those in favor of suspending the rules and taking up the resolution vote aye, those opposed vote no. Senator Waldron asking for a record vote. Once again, have you all voted? O.K. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting aye Senators Chambers, Clark, DeCamp, Fellman, Johnson, Kime, F. Lewis, Luedtke, Marsh, Marvel, Murphy, Savage, Schmit, Simpson, Stahmer, Waldron. Voting nay Senators Barnett, Cal Carsten, Fred Carstens, Cavanaugh, Dickinson, Epke, Fowler, Goodrich, Kelly, Kennedy, Kremer, R. Lewis, Mahoney, Maresh, Moylan, Nore, Skarda, Snyder, Stull, Syas, Warner, Whitney. Not voting Senators Anderson, Burbach, Carpenter, Duis, Hasebroock, Keyes, Proud, Rasmussen, Richendifer, Stromer and Wiltse. 16 ayes, 22 nays.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the motion has lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, reports on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB821 and find the same correctly enrolled. 754 correctly enrolled, 754A correctly enrolled. Signed Barbara Jackson, Enrolling Clerk. Mr. President your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day at 2:55 present to the Governor LB875, LB875A, LB1028, and LB1028A at 3:30 she presented LB131, LB826, LB826A, LB834, and LB834A and at 3:45 LB983, LB983A, LB861 and LB861A and LB945. PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I have signed LB821, 754 and 754A. Clerk will proceed with the Final Reading of LB665.

CLERK: (Read bill.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I would like to call attention to the body that we have got LB665 here on page 2, line 9, full-time should be underlined. I would like to call your attention to this error.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion to return LB665 to Select File to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: Stand by just a minute. Read the motion on the desk.

CLERK: I just did.

PRESIDENT: Alright, read it again.

CLERK: Where did it go. I move to return LB665 to Select File and strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: Alright the Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I made the motion but in view of the fact that the bill has already been read and there might be some question as to whether this can legally be done or not, I will ask unanimous consent to withdraw the motion and the vote can be taken on the bill itself anyway.
