CLERK: Final reading.

PRESIDENT: Alright, all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass? We will have to take a roll call vote on it while working on the board. Clear the board, then. All those in favor of the bill, vote aye; those opposed, vote nay. Once again, have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Thirty-four ayes; six nays and nine not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please for the final reading of LB 691.
