PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature please come to order. We are ready for prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call.

CLERK: Senator F. Carstens asked to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. Once again, have you all indicated your presence? Please register in. Ok, Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: OK, do we have corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any messages on the desk? Any notices?

CLERK: Read E & R report.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. While the legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I have signed, LB693, 705, and 740.

CLERK: Read unanimous request motion by Senator Burbach.
