CLERK: 10 ayes, 26 nays, 13 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion to return fails. We'll continue with the Final Reading of LB932.

CLERK: Read LB932.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is now is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor will vote yes. Those those opposed will vote no. Once again, the Chair is inquiring if you have all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read Record Vote. (Page 1667-68 of Journal).
35 ayes, 7 nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB933.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB933 to Select File to strike the enacting clause. Signed, Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw this motion. But while I'm speaking on the unanimous consent, I want to assure all of you in this Body that what Senator Fellman has caused will come home to all of you. Because if I've ever put my teeth into something to hold on with bulldog-like tenacity, this is it. And I'm telling you on the floor of this Legislature and everybody who hears my voice and everybody who is aware of what I say by any other means, this election that you're going to have for governor and lieutenant governor is going to have complications that some of you could have been aware now if you'd taken the time to listen. You chose not to. Whatever does occur is your responsibility. A good fight makes a fighter strong. I expect to be Hercules by this fall as a result of what we're going to do with Nebraska election process. So what you can't do on this is allow me to withdraw the motion by not objecting, then don't vote to pass the bill.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to withdrawal of the motion? Hearing none, so ordered. The motion is withdrawn. The Clerk will continue with the Final Reading of LB933. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB933.

CLERK: Read LB933.
