because of poor bookkeeping and accountancy, as between trying to compare one school district with another. There are no uniform accounting procedures in the state, unfortunately, and no one can tell for sure. But I would be afraid that this could lead into cut backs if we were to go any lower than what the committee originally recommended. And I would call to your mind that this was two million under what the State Department of Education felt they needed.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: I wonder if Senator Marvel would yield, to a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel yield.

SENATOR BURBACH: Senator Marvel, my question is this, and you may or not be able to answer now, but I would like to have the answer. Of these cuts, that we have here in the budget and of the figures that you gave us, \$2,862,537, etc. How many dollars are these over or under, but I'm sure they are over, of what the Budget Committee recommended. And with the action taken on the floor. Not necessarily would that answer be a change in my vote one way or the other, but I think it is a concern and we need to know what the Budget Committee recommended and what the figure actually is. Do you have that figure now, or can you update it?

SENATOR MARVEL: I think off the cuff, I can indicate to you if I understood your question right, that Agency 16, Department of Revenue, one half million dollars.

SENATOR BURBACH: This is the only one I am aware of. Senator Carpenter had an amendment for a million dollars, and I also put an amendment to his motion for five hundred thousand. And so this is possibly the only one I recognize. But there are others here, and what would be the total amount in 1053, 54 and 56, if you....

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, I'll have to get you that. In 1053, which we are considering now, I could give you that answer immediately. I'll get the other in a moment.

SENATOR BURBACH: And if there is other debate do you want to answer this question sometime later. Before we take a vote, I'd appreciate it.

SENATOR MARVEL: Now, the vote on 1053 would indicate that the increase put on by the floor was a half a million dollars. Agency 16, Department of Revenue.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, a question of Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Marvel here comes another question. Stand by.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes, Sir.
