Is there any Senator who has not voted? All right. Proceed with the tally. The tellers agree that Senator Nichol is elected Chairman of the Judiciary Committee and the Chair so declares. Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. Senator Don Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President and colleagues, I would like to place in nomination for Chairman of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, Senator Dave Newell from Omaha. Senator Newell has served as vice chairman very ably and very adeptly the past two years. I think Senator Newell has the expertise. He has the knowledge and he certainly has the commitment to serve you, this body, and the people of the State of Nebraska as Chairman of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.
