PRESIDENT: The motion carries. Do we have nominations? Chairman, Intergovernmental Cooperation. Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as retiring Chairman of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Committee, I would like to place in nomination the name of Senator Robert Clark of Sidney, Nebraska, presently serving as Vice Chairman of Intergovernmental Cooperation. Senator Clark, as we all are, is a member of the Council of State Governments. He's presently the Chairman of the twelve state Midwest Conference and does have in this year, 1979, the responsibility of planning and organizing the meeting to be held in this year in Omaha. So I would recommend to you very highly Senator Robert Clark of Sidney.

PRESIDENT: Are there further nominations? Seeing none, the Chair declares nominations closed and asks you to vote on the motion. Make the record.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays on the motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there further nominations? Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. Chairman, I think that Senator Cullan did such a fine job last year I would like to nominate his name again.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, no thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely, that should give you some indication of what they are doing to you. You will never be heard from again. Are there further nominations? Seeing none, the Chair declares the nominations are closed. Record your vote on Senator Cullan's motion. Make the record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.
