SPEAKER MARVEL: It is my pleasure to put in nomination for the Chairman of the Rules Committee, Senator Steve Fowler of Lincoln. It has been my privilege to work with Senator Fowler the last couple of years on the Executive Board. I know how hard he works. I know how hard he is willing to work. I also know that he is quite familiar with the legislative process and, therefore, I deem it a privilege to place his name in nomination.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will treat that as a change of the order by the Speaker. Is there an objection to that change? Seeing none, that shall be ordered, Senator Marvel. We go now to Item #17 on your agenda. My agenda has different numbers. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members, I move a committee of three to be appointed to escort the Secretary of State to the Chamber to deliver the election returns of the General Election of 1978.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion, record your vote. This is to proceed. Make the record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on Senator Cope's motion.

PRESIDENT: The Chair appoints Senator Fitzgerald, Senator George and Senator Keyes to the committee to escort the Secretary of State to the Chamber. We will stand at ease until the committee returns.
