SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, with this in mind, let's convene as follows: District, we are talking about Committee on Committees Districts, four of them. #1 will meet underneath the South balcony right over here. #2 back by the telephone booth. #3 over by the telephone booths under the North balcony. And the fourth one over here in the corner. One, two, three, four.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, there may need to be a Call of the House because there may not be sufficient persons on the floor at this moment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you move we go under Call, Senator Marsh?

SENATOR MARSH: I move we go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of going under Call, vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we are under Call. All legislators please take their seats. All unauthorized personnel is respectfully asked to leave the floor, and if you will clear the Board. Record your presence. We are under Call for the purpose of beginning to organize the Legislature into four caucus groups to make some selections as per Senator Marsh's instructions. Have you all recorded your presence? Senator Murphy, will you please record your presence? Senator Hefner, are you here? Senator Lamb, would you please record your presence? The Legislature is under Call. I am present.

CLERK: Senator Marvel is present.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh, we have 43 legislators present. Do you wish to proceed?

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, I request that the Call be raised for the purpose of meeting in caucuses.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Would you restate why we are going into caucuses because some of the legislators perhaps were not here when you made your original explanation.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Administrative Rules and Regulations Chair is Herb Duis. There are six members on that Committee, two from each of the three caucuses. Those three caucuses will meet as per the Executive Board caucus of yesterday. Then they will meet in four caucuses for the purpose of choosing one per caucus for the Rules, which is legislative rules, and for choosing a member to serve on
