GOVERNOR THONE: Delivered Inaugural Address found on pages 87-92 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now will the same escorts who escorted the individuals in please come forward and escort the same out and first the escorts for the Governor will please come forward and escort the Governor from the Chamber. Will the committee please come forward to escort the members of the Board of Education to the rear of the Chamber? Will the committee please come forward to escort the congressional delegation to the rear of the Chamber?
